Readings. Ephs. 1 : 15 - 23. & Matt. 25 : 31 - 46.

Sermon.

The theme for our service this week is : Jesus as King. In our reading from the letter to the church at Ephesus the Apostle Paul puts emphasis on Christ's highly exalted position -'above all'. In the gospel reading, The Sheep and the Goats, we see Jesus enthroned in heavenly glory. This is a strong theme in the book, Revelation. Paul reminds us of those who by faith have the hope of sharing in Christ's inheritance. Guided by Paul's writing, we will consider: the beginning of faith; its outflowing in love for the saints, (relevant to the gospel reading) and the finally the growth in the knowledge of God, that leads to a sure hope that we can share in this eternal inheritance.
